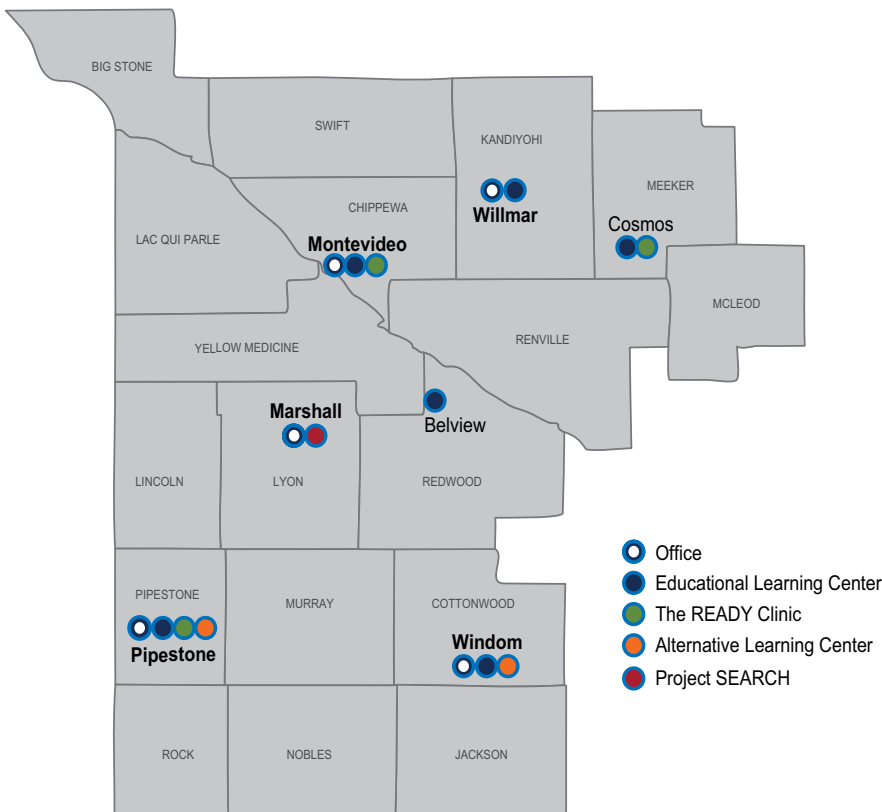
Service Area
