 - Try to get your teams to invitationals <u>at least</u> 15 minutes before the meet starts. If you are running late, please call the host coach.
 - When a team buzzes in and a question is stopped before being read in its entirety, readers should automatically begin to reread the question and teams do not have to request a reread. Readers should have a standard response like "I will reread the question."
 - Readers- stop reading as soon as a team buzzes in. Even one or two more words can be enough to give the team enough additional information to get the answer correct.

- There will only be one registration deadline- no early bird. Districts will be charged for the number of teams registered.
- Questions for schools hosting invites are being reviewed. If you haven't received your questions 10 days before your meet, please contact Gail.
- Scheduled invitationals are on the website. If anyone would like to add a date, contact Gail.
