
Daily Student Expectations

- → Login every school day
 - ◆ Pacing requires a minimum of 30 45 minutes per day per class
- → Take notes
 - ◆ If available, students should use Guided Notes
 - ◆ The option to take enotes is available for all courses
 - ◆ All notes can be used on quizzes and test
- → Check messages daily
 - respond to teachers promptly
- → Reach out via message or email to teachers when they need help

Best Practices

Tips for Setting Your Student Up For Success

- Designate a comfortable place free from distractions for your student.
- Offer structure, such as focus time, to increase engagement and promote progress.
- Ensure your student has access to ₩i and a charged device.
 - Consult your school if you need assistance with your device.
- Regularly check in on students to make sure they're actively working and learning or if they need help.
- We recommend frequently monitoring student's pacing and grades.
- Your Guardian account will allow you to keep track of your student's progress and allow you to help them be successful.

At-Home Support for Virtual Learning

The following questions can help students understand that even though this form of learning may be different, they're still expected to work and learn.

Consider asking your student:

- 1. Do you have any questions about what you learned?
- 2. What did your learning focus on today?
- 3. What did you accomplish today?
- 4. Did you find anything challenging today? If so how did you overcome the challenge?
- 5. How can you apply what you learned and/or what personal connections can you make to your learning.





Grade Breakdown


EXAMPLE EXPLANATION:

- Actual Grade
 — The average of completed graded activities deducting the behind pacing percentage
 amount if student falls behind pace.
- Overall Grade
 — The average of completed graded activities only (past due activities are not included).
- Relative Grade- The average of completed graded activities and zeros for every single activity that's left in the course to complete. This is the grade that will be used for final grades.

If a student is on pace or ahead of pace, the actual grade and overall grade will always match. If a student completes their course 100%, all three grades will match.

Messages


- Make sure students are checking their messages on a daily basis. Main area for communication with their teachers.
- Use the Guardian's message component to reach out to your student's teachers at any time



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
Course Information
