Approved by MDE, **STARRS Online Academy** is a K – 12 non-diploma program that expands educational opportunities for students. With the ability to remain enrolled in their home district, students can take **STARRS Online Academy** online courses to continue to meet their grade progression or graduation requirements by completing age-appropriate, engaging lessons with access to tools that support learning including text to speech, audio and translation, text and picture dictionaries and more. These courses are taught by Minnesota licensed teachers who specialize in online teaching. This program also meets Minnesota Academic Standards and uses assessment tools to measure student progress.

Offering **STARRS Online Academy** gives alternatives to students who may be:

- Looking for courses not offered in their district
- Looking for flexibility in their learning experience
- Looking for a Distance Learning option
- Credit deficient and wanting to graduate
- Struggling with a traditional school environment
