Career Expo Scavenger Hunt Assignment

Objective

Discover a variety of career paths, interact with professionals, and reflect on your interests by completing a series of challenges during the career expo.

How to Play

1. Get Your Scavenger Hunt Card:

Use the list of challenges below as your scavenger hunt card. Each challenge is worth points. The more points you earn, the higher your score!

2. Complete Challenges:

As you visit booths and presentations, complete as many challenges as possible. For each completed challenge, collect a signature or stamp from a representative at the booth.

3. Take Notes:

For each challenge, jot down a few sentences about what you learned or found interesting.

4. Reflection Bonus:

After the expo, write a short reflection (1 page) about your favorite discoveries and what careers you want to learn more about.

Scavenger Hunt Challenges

- Find a Career That Requires a College Degree (2 points)
 - Write down the degree needed and one interesting fact about the job.
- Find a Career That Doesn't Require a College Degree (2 points)
 - List the required training or certification and a skill needed for the job.
- Talk to Someone Who Has Worked in Their Field for Over 10 Years (3 points)
 - Ask what has changed most in their industry.
- Discover a Career You've Never Heard Of Before (3 points)
 - Describe what the job involves.
- Find a Booth That Offers Internships or Job Shadowing (2 points)
 - Note how students can apply.
- Ask a Professional What They Like Most About Their Job (2 points)
 - Write down their answer.
- Find a Career Related to Science, Technology, Engineering, or Math (STEM) (2 points)
 - List one cool project or tool used in this field.
- Find a Career in the Arts or Humanities (2 points)
 - Describe a creative skill needed for this job.
- Get Advice on Preparing for a Job Interview (2 points)
 - Write down one tip you received.
- Find Out About a Career That Involves Helping Others (2 points)
 - Explain how this job makes a difference.

Scoring

- Add up your points based on the challenges you complete.
- Bonus: Up to 5 extra points for a thoughtful reflection essay.

Submission Guidelines

- Turn in your scavenger hunt card with signatures/stamps and your notes.
- Attach your reflection essay.
- Include your name, date, and class period.

Due Date

Submit your completed scavenger hunt and reflection by the end of the week following the career expo.
