
Conference Date – January 4, 2024, at SMSU (snow date Jan. 5)

Junior High Knowledge Bowl® (teams of 6 students, grades 7-9)

Are you smarter than a 7th, 8th or 9th grader? You may not feel like it after you watch a round of a Junior High Knowledge Bowl competition. This academic contest encourages team members to work cooperatively to solve written and oral questions that test problem solving and critical thinking skills.

Senior High Knowledge Bowl is an interdisciplinary academic contest that combines intense competition with the incredible skill of knowledge recall. Through written and oral competition, young masterminds form teams and use brainpower to challenge others in teamwork, problem solving, interpersonal, oral communication, memory and listening skills.
