## 2-8-2024 FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE REGIONAL SPELLING BEE

The SWWC Service Cooperative's Regional Spelling Bee was held on Tuesday, February 6 at the Redwood Area Community Center in Redwood Falls. Twenty-nine students from 23 school districts participated in the Regional Bee. A big change this year came as all nine Minnesota Service Cooperatives in Minnesota have collaborated as one regional Spelling Bee partner. This allows the whole state of Minnesota the opportunity to send NINE Regional Bee Champions to the Scripps National Spelling Bee compared to the five in previous years. We are excited to give more students from Minnesota the opportunity to represent our state and compete against other kids around the United States.

Eighteen students battled it out in 12 rounds during the afternoon spelldown. To determine third place, Vera Prouty from Edgerton Christian, Roman Gaul and Urban Jacobson from Marshall Middle, Riley Stattelman from LQPV and Anthony Lerma from Worthington Middle had to go four rounds before Urban Jacobson claimed the third place trophy. The bee went another five rounds between Caitlyn Buss and Holland Vogel before declaring Holland Vogel the Regional Champion.

Holland Vogal, an 8<sup>th</sup> grader from Murray County Central will be heading to the Scripps National Spelling Bee on May 26 at Gaylord National Resort and Convention Center in National Harbor, Maryland.
